2 PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on October 5, 2020 at 9:00 a.m., or as soon
3 thereafter as may be heard in Courtroom 1, by the Honorable Jesus G. Bernal, at the
4 above-titled Court, located at 3470 Twelfth Street, Riverside, California 92501,
5 Plaintiffs Wendy Gish, Patrick Scales, James Dean Moffatt, and Brenda Wood
6 (“Plaintiffs”), by and through counsel, will and hereby do move this Court pursuant
7 to Rule 60(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Local Rule 7-18 for
8 reconsideration of the Court’s July 8, 2020 Order Granting Defendants’ Motions to
9 Dismiss (Dkt. 76) (the “Order”). This Motion is made following the conference of
10 counsel pursuant to the Court’s standing order, which took place by phone on August
11 6, 2020.

12 Plaintiffs’ Motion for Reconsideration is made on the grounds that new
13 material facts have emerged since the time of this Court’s ruling on Defendants’
14 motions to dismiss for reasons of mootness. Specifically, Defendants—pursuant to
15 same executive order challenged by Plaintiffs in their Complaint—have reinstated
16 their ban on all indoor worship services across dozens of counties, including
17 Riverside and San Bernardino Counties, where Plaintiffs seek to attend or hold
18 worship services.

19 This Motion is supported by the accompanying Memorandum of Points and
20 Authorities, by Plaintiffs’ Complaint, and all exhibits attached thereto, by the
21 declaration of Harmeet K. Dhillon filed herewith, all prior filings and submissions to
22 the Court in this action, and by such further argument and evidence that may be
23 adduced at any hearing on this matter or of which the Court may take judicial notice.
