Plaintiffs Melinda Antonucci and Casey Mathieu file this Motion under Rule 65(a) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and ask this Court to issue a Preliminary Injunction against the above-captioned Defendants. This Motion is supported by: (1) the attached Memorandum in Support, and (2) the Verified Complaint (ECF No. 1), along with the exhibits attached thereto. Further, Plaintiffs respectfully request oral argument on this Motion.

Plaintiffs move for this Court to enjoin Defendants, and all other persons who are in active concert or participation with them, as follows:

- 1. To stop efforts to revoke Plaintiffs' foster care license;
- 2. To refrain from otherwise excluding Plaintiffs from Vermont's foster-care program;

- 3. To refrain from requiring Plaintiffs to commit to facilitating a hypothetical foster child's "gender affirming care" through social or medical transition as a condition for maintaining their foster care license; and
- 4. If Defendants maintain that foster children must receive "gender affirming care," to allow Plaintiffs to opt-out of fostering transgender-identifying children (1) at the placement stage and (2) if a child comes to have a transgender identity while in their care.
